Marco Buti holds the Tommaso Padoa-Schioppa chair in Economic Integration and Monetary Policy at the European University Institute. He was Head of Cabinet of Commissioner for Economy Paolo Gentiloni from 2019 to 2023, Director General for Economic and Financial Affairs of the European Commission from 2008 to 2019 and Deputy Minister of Finances for the G7 and the G20. A graduate of the universities of Florence and Oxford, he was visiting professor at various European universities. He has published books and articles on the Economic and Monetary Union, the political economy of European integration, macroeconomic policies, welfare state reforms and global governance. His new book, “Was Jean Monnet right? Building Europe in times of crisis”, was published in April 2023.
