Marcello Messori holds the Poste Italiane chair in “European Economy and European Economic Governance” at the Department of Economics and Finance, Luiss University (Rome). He is the co-coordinator of the Group on Europe at the Astrid Foundation. He was Visiting Professor in several European Universities (such as Sciences-Po, Paris X-Nanterre, LATAPSES, Université de Nice) and Visiting Scholar at MIT (Cambridge Ma.) and Stanford, among others. He has published approximately three hundred works in Italian, English, French, and German. In recent years, his main field of research has been the analysis of the European Union’s economy with specific reference to financial markets and monetary and fiscal policies. He has coordinated national and international research groups and has been involved in various institutional activities. In particular, he was president of the Italian Railways company and president of the Italian association of asset management (Assogestioni). Currently, he is president of Allianz Bank and member of the Board of Directors of Investitori Sgr (where he previously served as president).
