

Bernardo Giorgio Mattarella

Bernardo Giorgio Mattarella is full professor of administrative law at the Luiss Guido Carli Department of Law of. He is director of the law degree course, director of the "Vittorio Bachelet" research center on public administrations, and director of the inter-university master's degree in administrative law.

He obtained a Master of laws (University of California at Berkeley, 1992), PhD in public law (University of Florence, 1997) and won the "Giuseppe Mantellini" Prize for State Science, conferred by the Accademia Nazionale dei Lincei (2008).

Bernardo Giorgio Mattarella is Deputy editor and editor in chief of the Quarterly review of public law. He spoke at about 500 scientific conferences in Italy and abroad, authoring about 450 scientific publications.

He was study assistant to constitutional judges Enzo Cheli (1996), Guido Neppi Modona (1996-1997) and Sabino Cassese (2007-2009), and was Head of the Legislative Office of the Minister of Education, University and Research (2013-2014) and of the Minister of Simplification and Public Administration (2014-2016).
