Donato Di Carlo is lecturer in Political Economy at Luiss University and managing director of the Luiss Hub for New Industrial Policy and Economic Governance (LUHNIP). He obtained his PhD in European Political Economy from the Max Planck Institute for the Study of Societies (MPIfG) in Cologne.
