Giovanna Vallanti is Associate Professor of Economics at LUISS Guido Carli University (Rome), Director of the BA Program in Economics and Business and scientific coordinator of the LUISS Lab of European Economics. She received her PhD in Economics at the London School of Economics in 2004. Subsequently, she was researcher at the European Central Bank, at the Italian National Statistical Institute (ISTAT) and a research fellow at the Centre for Economic Performance at LSE.

Her main area of research is applied labour economics. She has worked extensively on the performance of labour markets with emphasis on the role of labour market institutions and technological progress in explaining employment dynamics and firms' performance. She has also followed the causes of gender inequalities in labour market outcomes, in a historical perspective and across countries, with emphasis on the role of labour market institutions and policies. Her works have appeared in international journals such as *International Economic Review, Economic Journal, Research Economic, Journal of Law and Economics, Labour Economics*.
