His publications have appeared in international economics and finance journals such as Journal of European of Economic Association, Journal of Monetary Economics, Journal of Financial Economics, Economic Journal, Journal of Economic Theory, Journal of International Economics, Review of Economic Dynamics, International Economic Review, Journal of Money, Credit and Banking, European Economic Review, and Review of Finance. With Marcello Messori and Irene Tinagli he edited the book *Identita'* del Fare. Economia e Diritti nell'Europa del XXI Secolo (Luiss Press), with contributions written by the young winners of the Jo Cox Europe prize.
