Paolo Canofari is Associate Professor of Economic Policy at Marche Polytechnic University (UNIVPM). He holds a Ph.D. in International Economics from the University of Rome Tor Vergata. From 2020 to 2024, he served as an independent expert for the European Parliament in monetary dialogue with the European Central Bank. Previously, he was a researcher at the LUISS School of European Political Economy (2013–2024) and an assistant professor in economics at LUISS (2018–2019). He has taught Macroeconomics and European Macroeconomics at LUISS University in Rome, as well as Monetary Policy in the Ph.D. program in Economics at UNIVPM. Currently, he coordinates the UNIVPM unit of the national research project (Prin 2022) “Public and Corporate Debt, Monetary Policy, and Macroeconomic Stability”. He is a member of the LUISS unit of the national research project (Prin 2020) “Jumpstarting Europe. New Macroeconomic Policies after the Great Crises”. His research focuses on European macroeconomic policies, the interaction between fiscal and monetary policy, the impact of European monetary policy on firms’ activity, public debt sustainability, and macroeconomic data filtering.
