Francesca Lotti is a Lead Economist and Program Manager at the Institute for Economic Development of the World Bank, where she works on productivity, firm dynamics, and growth-oriented policy design. Prior to that she led the Firms and Regional Analysis Division at the Bank of Italy. Her research focuses on economic growth, industrial organization, innovation, firm dynamics, and evidence-based industrial and growth policies, with a strong emphasis on translating micro-level evidence into actionable policy insights. Francesca is a member of the CEPR Research Policy Network on Growth, Innovation and Social Model in Europe, led by Prof. Philippe Aghion. She teaches graduate-level courses at Luiss University on industry dynamics, innovation, and the economics of growth. Her academic work has been published in leading international journals, including *Econometrica*. She has held visiting positions at Harvard University and the National Bureau of Economic Research and serves on editorial and advisory boards of academic journals. She holds a PhD in Economics from the Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies.
