

Pierfrancesco Angeleri

Pierfrancesco Angeleri, after graduating in Engineering from the University of Rome "La Sapienza," joined IBM in 1985 as a researcher at the "European Center for Engineering and Scientific Computing" research center in Rome.

In 1991, Angeleri began his career in sales, serving as Sales Manager, Marketing Manager, and Branch Manager at IBM Italy. He moved to Amsterdam in 1997 to serve as General Manager of the Printing Systems Division for Europe.

In 1999, he assumed the role of Server Vice President for the Southern Europe Region, and in 2001, he was appointed Vice President of System xSeries Europe at the Paris headquarters.

In 2003, he returned to Italy, where he held various positions within IBM's Southern Europe Region, including Vice President of the Transportation and Distribution Market, Vice President of Software, and Vice President of Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises. In 2012, he was appointed Vice President of Channels.

Having joined Wolters Kluwer in May 2014, he was appointed Managing Director, Tax & Accounting Italy and a member of the Board of Directors of the company's Italian subsidiary.

After serving on the General Council of AssoSoftware as a Director, Angeleri was elected President of the Association in 2022.

Since 2025, he has also been President of the Foundation for the Promotion and Monitoring of the ETS Software Producers' Code of Conduct.
